We have supported 70 children and their families, providing rice, sugar and flour. We have also been able pay small salaries to the nurse, nutritionist and cook. Through your help, we have managed to treat children with problems of malnutrition, skin disease, plus a few with malaria or typhoid. In particular this year, we have been providing for the children of two families after the mothers died, with the fathers already long-term absent. We hope next year to be able to respond more effectively to the need for clothes, shoes and medicines for the children.
